Straker Charitable Foundation, was a fantastic success and has drawn state and national attention for its impact and creativity. 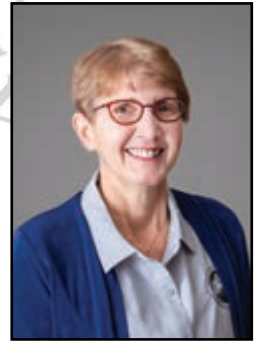

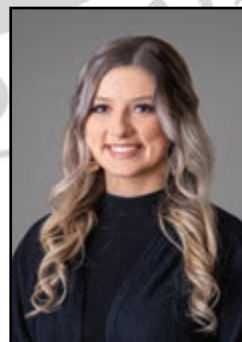

FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT

Friends,

In my first year as Board President, I am humbled by the continued successes of the Community Foundation because of those who came before me.



The seeds that were planted years ago are coming to fruition now. One of the shining examples of 2022 was introducing the Make Muskingum Home program. This idea began some time ago as Muskingum County saw the “brain drain” of young people leaving to find opportunities away from home and even out of state. With the generosity of the Straker Foundation, 13 individuals and their families will stay in our community for the next five years, hopefully longer. We expect to award more young people this opportunity for student loan forgiveness in the near future.

MCCF is not only for the community, but also with the community. We raise funds to give back to non-profit organizations, and we collaborate with groups to support local events that bring people together. 2022 was the second year of the Southeastern Ohio Beer and Wine Fest, which made downtown Zanesville a hub for residents and visitors to spend an afternoon enjoying beverages made by local breweries and wineries. 2022 also saw the revival of Zane’s Trace Commemoration, a weekend-long event to celebrate the history of Zanesville and showcase the many aspects that make our community unique. The Commemoration was supported, in part, by MCCF through the Spring Grant competition.

None of this would be possible without **you**. A community foundation is as strong as the people who support it, and MCCF has a wide net of supporters who believe in creating good change in Muskingum County. We are able to give back to the community because you give to the Foundation. Every contribution matters, and the stories in this year’s annual report show the impact people like you have made.

I invite you to be a part of what MCCF is doing. We welcome the movers and shakers who see big opportunities in Muskingum County to collaborate with us. With a little dedication and a lot of communication, we can make it possible. We are here for you, we are here for giving, and we are here for good.

2022 CYF YOU MATTER 5K



The Muskingum County Community Youth Foundation hosted its second annual **"You Matter 5K"** race on May 1.

The run was put on by CYF and **I Am A Warrior Against Suicide**, a local non-profit organization, to raise awareness about mental health struggles and suicide prevention. The event took place at the Collegial Woods Trail. Around 150 people participated in the race.

The 5K was originally slated to take place in May 2020, but the COVID-19 pandemic pushed everything back a year. The success of the first race in 2021 propelled CYF to host again in 2022.

Proceeds were shared between CYF and I Am A Warrior Against Suicide, raising **\$2,500** for each. I Am a Warrior Against Suicide used the proceeds for placing more crisis hotline signs throughout the county, and CYF used the proceeds for funding additional projects in the 2022-2023 year, including the annual Youth Grant Competition.

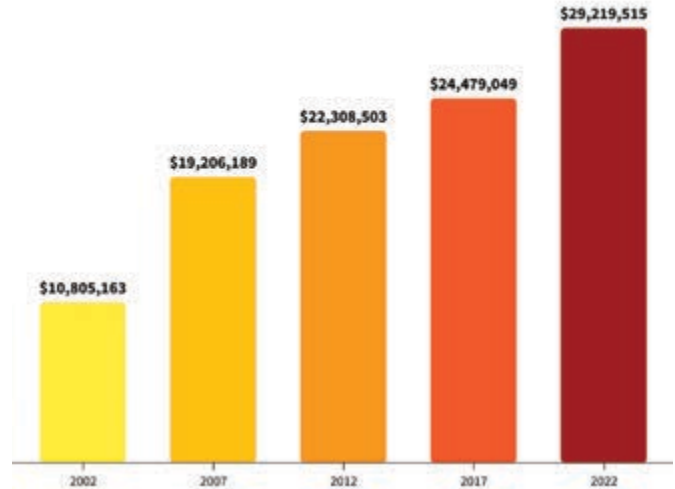

Year 2022 Unaudited

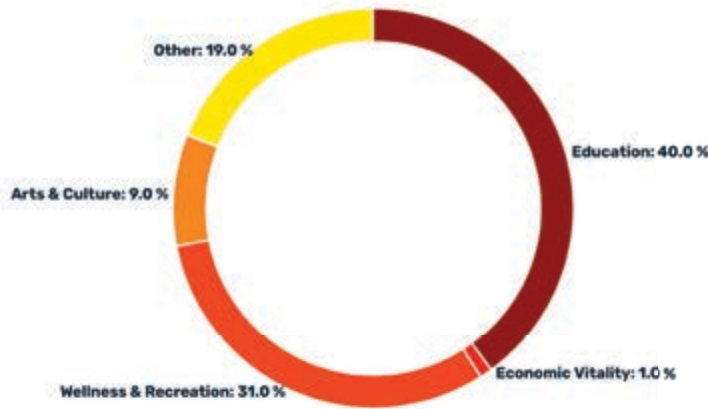
The Muskingum County Community Foundation's assets continue to show growth as we look back over the last 20 years. Assets include cash, investment accounts, property, equipment, etc.

2022 Grants

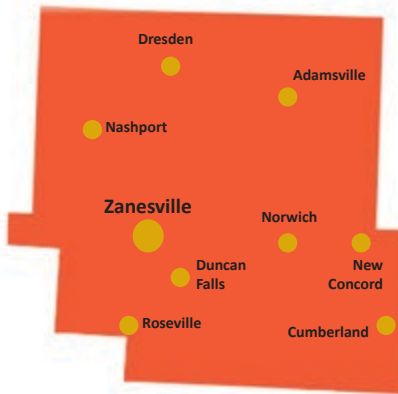


In 2022, MCCF awarded more than **\$1.2 million** in grants and scholarships.

GREAT GROUNDHOG GIVE-A-WAY

Due to public health concerns, the 2022 MCCF Groundhog Day Celebration was moved into a virtual setting.

In lieu of a live and silent auction held in person, the auction was moved entirely online. Images of the 50 featured items were listed on the auction website. The online auction began on January 28 at 6 PM and concluded at Noon on February 2.

The **Great Groundhog Give-A-Way Raffle Drawing** was livestreamed on the MCCF Facebook Page on February 2, 2022. Ten prizes, each valued at \$1,000 or more, were raffled off to lucky winners.

Additionally, CEO Brian Wagner and the MCCF groundhog visited representatives of the 2022 Groundhog Day sponsors in the days leading up to the start of the online auction. This allowed MCCF to thank the sponsors in person and to give them an opportunity to share other ways their organizations give back to the community.

The groundhog also learned his name through an online naming contest: Gus!

Despite cancelling the in-person event, the 2022 MCCF Groundhog virtual activities still met success. The event raised more than **\$45,000**, all of which benefited the annual Spring Grant Competition.

BUDDING GARDENERS



“Our goal for this project was to provide teachers and youth educators with supplies to support educational horticultural gardening projects for youth while fulfilling the outreach mission of Ohio State University Extension and the **Master Gardener Volunteer Program**. This goal was achieved by providing seed starting kits to youth leaders to use in their classrooms or programs.

This program released project supplies to 16 educators in elementary schools, middle schools, child care programs, head start programs, public library, and a juvenile facility. An average of 17 students were reached across each project according to post-survey respondents. Populations included K-12th grade youth and youth with disabilities. A team of 5 adult volunteers helped administer the program.”

MAKE MUSKINGUM HOME

The Muskingum County Community Foundation and the J.W. and M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation are pleased to announce the names of the 2023 **Make Muskingum Home** program winners.

“Make Muskingum Home,” a recently established talent attraction and retention program in Muskingum County, will make payments toward student loan debt of up to \$10,000 a year for five years for successful applicants who live and work in Muskingum County. The finalists went through a rigorous application process that began in fall 2022, which included an online application as well as a video submission to explain why they are choosing to make Muskingum County their home community.

A joint effort by The Muskingum County Community Foundation and the **J.W. and M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation**, the program sought applicants who recently graduated with student loan debt and who will commit to living and working in Muskingum County for five years. Non-county residents must relocate to Muskingum County within 90 days of being accepted, and applicants must also become involved in the Muskingum County community.

“We are extremely pleased to be able to award this special grant program to 13 outstanding individuals,” said MCCF CEO Brian Wagner. “This talent attraction and retention program is the first of its kind in the region, and we’re excited to initiate the effort to keep Muskingum County thriving with people who are contributing to their community.”

The winners of this year’s round of Make Muskingum Home have committed to living and working in Muskingum County for the next five years. Additionally, they must be involved in organizations that are active in community improvement efforts. The Muskingum County Community Foundation and the J.W. & M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation intend to open the second annual Make Muskingum Home competition later this year if funds are secured.

“The J.W. & M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation’s vision is ‘building a stronger community with opportunity and promise,’” said Susan Holdren, President and Executive Director of the J.W. & M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation. “We believe the ‘Make Muskingum Home’ project aligns well with our vision since bringing working people to our community will enhance the area we call home.”

Members of The Muskingum County Community Foundation and the J.W. & M.H. Straker Charitable Foundation spent the first few weeks of the new year surprising winners across the county. They were also honored at the MCCF Groundhog Day Celebration on January 27, 2023.

COMMUNITY CARES FOR THE ARTS



An old photo of the Zanesville Masonic Temple from the National Register of Historic Places.

The Zanesville Masonic Temple was a six-story building originally built in 1903 that stood in downtown Zanesville. Not only was the Temple used for Masonic purposes, but it housed government and personal offices as well as commercial shops. It was also a popular site for the First Friday Art Walks. The Masonic Temple had become a staple to the downtown community, serving as a hub for artists and small businesses alike.

On the night of January 6, a fire broke out at the Masonic Temple. The fire began on the third floor and quickly engulfed the entire building. While no one was injured, 120 years of local history was destroyed in a single night.

The morning after the fire, The Muskingum County Community Foundation reactivated the **Community Cares Fund** that was created in 2020 during the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. This time, MCCF partnered with the Zanesville Appalachian Arts Project to help raise funds for the Masonic Temple artists who lost their materials in the fire. More than **\$108,000** was raised by members of the community to give artists funds to purchase new art supplies.

Since the fire and eventual demolition of the Masonic Temple, the artists and businesses have found new homes throughout Muskingum County. Many former Temple tenants came together to help create the Y-Bridge Cultural Arts Center, located on Main Street as visitors come off the Y-Bridge. Others have taken up shop with businesses in the Zanesville area.

MEET A 2021 FALL GRANT WINNER

Getting assistance at the right time can and does make a difference. This grant was the difference between watching a problem and resolving a situation. The Gant Foundation is composed of volunteers, individuals that donate their time energy and money to preserve and protect the Gant House. Sometimes looking at a list of problems without readily available solutions can demoralize even the best team. This grant gave us hope. It let us see that others believe in our mission for the community. It gave us an opportunity to solve some of the existing problems and take steps to prevent others.

Preserve and protect was the theme of this MCCF grant for us. We have along the way identified projects which will require more time and expertise. Our door, which we needed to protect so that we could someday restore it to its original beauty, and our windows that are not energy efficient, represent a major project for the future. We believe that our efforts with this grant attracted the attention of a special donor that will help us reach our new goal.

Since receiving this grant many doors of cooperation and assistance have opened and we will continue to benefit from the support and trust of the Muskingum County Community Foundation.

PAST PRESIDENTS BREAKFAST

The Muskingum County Community Foundation hosted a **Past Presidents Breakfast** on September 21. In addition to recognizing current and former leaders of MCCF, the ceremony also honored individuals with special awards.

Brian Diamond was named as the 2022 recipient of the **Brian T. Wagner Community Leadership Award**.

Diamond is the owner of iTrack, LLC, a custom website development company located in Muskingum County. Through iTrack, Diamond works in the community to promote businesses and their products. Diamond and his wife, Mary, are also the owners of 630 Main, an event and meeting venue located in downtown Zanesville. They have also recently purchased the former Olde Towne Antiques building to start a multi-vendor food hall, similar to the Short North Market in Columbus. Additionally, Diamond is the head of the Zanesville Downtown Association and also a board member of The Zanesville-Muskingum County Chamber of Commerce and Goodwill Industries.

Tom Barone was named as the honoree of the 2022 **Dick Johnson Civic Leadership Award**.

Barone's career spanned over 45 years in three states; he managed mental health facilities in New York and Indiana from 1969 to 1979. Upon moving to Zanesville in 1979, he worked at the Good Samaritan Medical Center until 1996. Barone then worked at Rankin and Rankin Insurance Services until his retirement in 2014. Barone has been active with the Zanesville-Muskingum County Chamber of Commerce, the Zanesville Port Authority, and the Zanesville Country Club. He has also been a board member for the St. Thomas Finance Committee, Bishop Rosecrans High School, Six County Mental Health, and The Community Bank.

Bob Grayson was named the recipient of the 2022 **Ray Thomas Community Service Award**.

Grayson was the building manager for the Zanesville Masonic Temple. On the night of January 6, a fire broke out at the Masonic Temple and quickly ravaged the entire building. Over four dozen tenants lost their work in one night. Grayson kept the temple tenants together by hosting meetings as a way of coping with the loss and determining how to move forward. He worked with the Zanesville Appalachian Arts Project to redistribute donations generated from the MCCF Community Cares Fund to help artists purchase new supplies to continue creating new works.

Heather Sands-Davis was presented the 2022 **Bob Beam Award**.

Sands worked 18 years at MCCF in various positions, including director of Scholarship Central and GEAR-UP. Through her efforts, Scholarship Central's programming expanded to provide higher education assistance to high school and college students in and around Muskingum and Perry counties.

THE FUTURE OF COLLEGE ACCESS

Scholarship Central



Access Program

Scholarship Central Access Program was established in 2000 to provide local high school students and their families information about colleges, scholarships, and financial aid resources. This has included offering FAFSA workshops, one-on-one advising appointments, and events like College Night. Additionally, Scholarship Central has offered ACT prep classes.

Scholarship Central has worked with multiple grant programs, including the AmeriCorps Ohio College Guide program, to give recent college graduates the opportunity to delve into helping their community with educational services. Scholarship Central also worked with a FAFSA grant program to encourage higher FAFSA completion rates at local high schools. Scholarship Central was also key in providing services through the GEAR UP Program, a federally funded grant that worked with students and families at their school to assist in setting their career and college goals after high school.

Like all things, the passing of time has indicated new needs in the community, and the way resources are provided has changed as well. Most MCCF scholarships are now available through an online application. Students and their families are able to fill out the FAFSA with little assistance. The ACT testing is now mandatory for all high school juniors, so the classes are not as in demand as they used to be.



The 2021-2022 school year saw the end of an era. The **GEAR UP** Program concluded its eighth and final year at Crooksville Exempted Village School District. GEAR UP collaborated with the staff of Crooksville and other community initiatives to create activities that encouraged participation among the student body, including college visits, day trips, Dude Be Kind Week, and Signing Day. Signing Day is a special event that celebrates graduating seniors in their choice of attending college, military, or workforce. In 2022, **69 seniors** at Crooksville High School participated in Signing Day.

All GEAR UP students were eligible to receive a GEAR UP Scholarship through this program. Over the 8 years of the program's existence at Crooksville, this scholarship was awarded to **202** students, distributing **\$400,262.50** in scholarship funds to students who participated in the GEAR UP program and graduated from Crooksville High School.

With the changing of staff at Scholarship Central and the conclusion of the GEAR UP grant, The Muskingum County Community Foundation has taken this opportunity to reevaluate how to best serve students and assist in their goals after high school. Since joining MCCF in August 2022, Beth Fox and Andrea Polen have dedicated their time to determine the best practices for working with scholarship funds and committees on selecting winners. They have also met with members of other community foundations to learn about their methods and what can be improved upon with our own methods.

Changes are being made to improve what Scholarship Central is currently doing, with the ultimate goal to adapt to the ever changing culture of our community. We look forward to improving our practices so we can better serve Muskingum County for years to come in the 21st century.
